Call to Worship from Zephaniah 3

L: “For at that time I will change the speech of the peoples to a pure speech,

All: that all of them may call upon the name of the Lord and serve him with one accord.

L: The Lord has taken away the judgments against you; he has cleared away your enemies.

All: The King of Israel, the Lord, is in your midst; you shall never again fear evil.

L: On that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: Fear not, O Zion; let not your hands grow weak.

All: The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.
